# GAME NOTES

## HEADLINES

After three preseason games, seventh-round selection **QB Greg McElroy** leads all rookies in passer rating (90.6), passing attempts (53), completions (33), touchdown passes (2) and passing yards (306). McElroy is expected to see significant time against the Eagles.

Through the preseason, **Jets quarterbacks** Mark Sanchez and Greg McElroy have combined for a passer rating of 96.1, completing 56-of-96 passes (61.4%) for 586 yards and five touchdowns with no interceptions.

Second-year **LB Josh Mauga**, and rookie **LB Nick Bellore**, both undrafted, have provided quality depth at inside linebacker. The two have combined for 21 tackles, two sacks and one interception during the preseason.

The **Jets defense has picked off six passes** during the preseason, after recording just 12 interceptions in 2010. The **starting defense** has allowed only 13 points in 16 drives.

For the preseason, the Jets have recorded a plus-four in the take-away/give-away category, tied for second-best in the NFL this preseason. All six of the defense's turnovers have come on interceptions, while New York's two give-aways have come on fumbles.

# OVERVIEW BY POSITION

## Quarterbacks (4), Returning Starter (1)

### Coach Matt Cavanaugh:

**Mark Sanchez** finished the 2010 season with a career-high 3,291 yards, 17 touchdowns and 13 interceptions for a passer rating of 75.3 on the season. His six career rushing touchdowns ties him for fourth amongst Jets quarterbacks in club history. He became only the second quarterback (Ben Roethlisberger 5, 2004-05) to start and win four postseason games in their first two seasons in the NFL. Sanchez recorded a 127.3 passer rating on 16-of-25 passing for 194 yards and three touchdowns in the club's win at NE (1/16). It was the first time he has thrown three touchdown passes in a postseason game, and tied the club record for most in a single postseason game. He led the Jets on a five-play, 40-yard game-winning drive, in which he completed all three of his passes for 38 yards in the Wild Card victory at IND (1/8). The Jets win marked Sanchez's third postseason win, the most by any QB in franchise history. In 2011, he has focused on improving his completion percentage. Through three preseason games, Sanchez has completed 60.5% of his passes on 26-of-43 passing for 280 yards, 3 TD and 0 INT. Veteran **Mark Brunell** signed with the Jets as a free agent (7/28/10). The three-time Pro Bowler, has missed both preseason games due to injury. 2011 seventh-round selection **Greg McElroy** has seen extended action in both preseason games, attempting the most passes (53), completing the most throws (33) and recording the highest passer rating (90.6) of any rookie. First-year passer **Drew Willy**, who has seen limited action this preseason, hails from Randolph, NJ, just nine miles from the team's Florham Park, NJ facility.

## Running Backs (6), Returning Starter (1)

### Coach Anthony Lynn:

After spending two seasons as an understudy to Thomas Jones and LaDainian Tomlinson, **Shonn Greene** is slated to start at running back. In preseason action, he has averaged 4.6 yards a carry on 16 rushes. Greene finished the 2010 season with 766 yards and two touchdowns on 185 carries and added 70 yards on 19 carries in the Wild Card victory at IND (1/8). He registered his third postseason rushing touchdown, tied for most in franchise history, when he raced 16 yards for the Jets final score of the game at NE (1/16). For his career, Greene has a 5.0 yard-per-carry average, the best among Jets rushers all-time that have carried the ball at least 40 times. **Tomlinson** is expected to serve as the Jets third-down back in 2010 after he led the team with 914 yards and six rushing touchdowns on 219 carries last season. His 52 receptions were second on the team. He recorded the second-most productive postseason game of his career at IND (1/8) when he rushed for two touchdowns and 82 yards on 16 carries (5.1 avg.). Second-year fullback **John Conner** enters 2011 as the starter after spending one season learning from Tony Richardson. Known as "The Terminator" for his crushing blocks, Conner rushed for 44 yards and his first NFL touchdown on eight carries in 2010 season finale vs. BUF (1/2). 2010 fourth-round selection out of USC, **Joe McKnight**, amassed a Jet season-high when he rushed for 158 yards on 32 carries vs. BUF (1/2). He is currently the Jets leading rusher this preseason with 95 yards on 21 carries. Fourth-round selection **Bilal Powell** has shown versatility and a powerful rushing style, recording 58 rushing yards, a touchdown and 29 receiving yards on four receptions. Young-veteran **Chris Jennings**, who registered the longest run (69-yards) in the preseason since RB Curtis

Martin in 1999.

## Wide Receivers (9), Returning Starters (1)

### Coach Henry Ellard:

The lone starter returning in 2011 is **Santonio Holmes**. Since 1983, no NFL receiver has caught more touchdown passes (5) in the final 1:00 of 4th quarter/overtime (including playoffs) than Holmes. Super Bowl XLIII MVP re-signed with the Jets this offseason and was named captain by Coach Ryan. The new members of the Jets receiving corps are 10-year veteran Plaxico Burress, fifth-round selection Jeremy Kerley and 15-year veteran Derrick Mason. **Burress** returns to the NFL since last seeing action in 2008. He saw his first action in Week Two of the preseason vs. CIN (8/21) and recorded three catches for 66 yards, including a 21-yard touchdown reception. **Kerley**, the leading candidate to replace Brad Smith in the Jets Wildcat package, has recorded a rush, a pass attempt and a reception during the preseason. **Mason** brings his 924 (fourth among active players) career receptions to New York, after spending six seasons with Baltimore. Young veterans **Patrick Turner** and **Logan Payne** along with rookies **Michael Campbell**, **Dan DePalma**, and seventh-round selection **Scotty McKnight** round out the receiving corp.

## Tight Ends (5), Returning Starter (1)

### Coach Mike Devlin:

Fourth-year **Dustin Keller** finished first on the team in receptions (55), and third in touchdowns (5) and receiving yards (687) last season. **Matthew Mulligan** and former undrafted rookie free agent **Jeff Cumberland** have both seen action as extra tight ends this preseason. Cumberland leads all Jet receivers with eight receptions for 120 yards in only two preseason appearances. **Josh Baker** has seen action in all three preseason games and has caught three passes for 45 yards. Third-year veteran **Keith Zinger** rounds out the unit.

## Offensive Line (12), Returning Starters (5)

### Coach Bill Callahan:

In 2006, Jets General Manager Mike Tannenbaum focused on the offensive line, selecting **LT D'Brickshaw Ferguson** fourth overall and **C Nick Mangold** 29th overall in the NFL draft. The two players have started 80 consecutive games together, making them the only two players who entered the league together to start their team's first 75 regular-season games on the same offensive line since 1970. Ferguson earned his second-consecutive Pro Bowl nod for his play last season. He was also awarded 2010 Pro Football Weekly's Midseason All-Pro team honors, 2009 Pro Bowl honors and 2006 All-Rookie Team honors by Pro Football Weekly and the Pro Football Writer's Association. During his first four seasons, Mangold earned 2009 Associated Press All-Pro honors, three consecutive Pro Bowl selections (08, 09, 10) and All-Rookie recognition in 2006 as voted by Pro Football Weekly and the Pro Football Writer's Association. Also on the offensive line is third-year **LG Matt Sluson**, who earned the starting job after an impressive 2010 offseason and started every game last season. **RG Brandon Moore** leads the group and has started 105 consecutive games for the Jets. **T Wayne Hunter** who earned his first-career start at right tackle at PIT (12/19) and also started at CHI (12/26) and vs. BUF (1/2). Hunter also started the club's 28-21 win at NE (1/16) and the AFC Championship game at PIT (1/23). Second-year players **G/T Vladimir Ducasse** and **G Matt Kroul** fill out the group along with first-year linemen **Trevor Canfield**, **Pete Clifford**, **Dennis Landolt** and **Nevin McCaskill**, in

addition to rookie **Zane Taylor**.

### Defensive Line (9), Returning Starters (2)

#### Coach Mark Carrier and Jeff Weeks:

Led by veteran starter **DT Mike DeVito** (5th season) and defensive captain **NT Sione Pouha** (7th season), the Jets field a defensive line with seven players who have three-or-less years of experience. The group was infused with two draft selections this season, **DE Muhammad Wilkerson** (first round, 30th overall) and **NT Kenrick Ellis** (third round, 94th overall). DeVito earned 11 starts and recorded 46 tackles in 2010. Pouha has started 29 games in the last two seasons for a defense that finished first overall in 2009 and fourth in 2010. He finished tied for the most tackles among Jets defensive linemen with 46 and recovered a team-high three fumbles and had two sacks last season. **Marcus Dixon**, who was awarded to the Jets off waivers (9/5/10) and registered his first-career sack when he dragged downed Bears QB Jay Cutler at CHI (12/26), helps provide depth along with **Jarron Gilbert** and **Ropati Pitoitua**, who missed all of 2010 due to an injury. Rounding out the defensive line are **Martin Tevaseu**, who saw action in the AFC Championship and has played in all three preseason games with a start vs. CIN (8/21) and at NYG (8/29), and first-year player **Lorenzo Washington**.

### Linebackers (12), Returning Starters (4)

#### Coach Bob Sutton:

Led by inside linebackers David Harris and Bart Scott and flanked by versatile linebackers Bryan Thomas and Calvin Pace, this unit allows the Jets defense to be one of the most multiple in the league. **Harris**, was re-signed to a long-term deal this offseason after he led the team in tackles for the third time in his four year career with 119 tackles and registered three sacks, a FR and two passes defensed. **Scott**, who is the tone-setter for the Jets defense, finished second on the team with 94 tackles, one sack, one forced fumble and one pass defensed. The reliable **Thomas** finished with 41 tackles, a team-leading six sacks, one pass defensed, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery. It was the first time he led the team in sacks since 2006, when he recorded 8.5. **Pace** missed the first four games of 2010 due to an injury and finished second on the team in sacks with 5.5. He recorded three sacks in the postseason. Second-year LB **Josh Mauga** has solidified himself as the third inside linebacker after serving on special teams last season. In the preseason to date, he is tied for the team lead in tackles (7), has one sack and an interception. He has seen action with both the first-team and second-team units. Third-year man **Jamaal Westerman** provides depth on the outside along with **Eddie Jones**, and **Garrett McIntyre**. Filling in at the inside linebacker positions are **Brashton Satele**, former Central Michigan teammates, **Nick Bellore** and **Matthias Berning** and **Joey LaRocque**.

### Defensive Backs (15), Returning Starters (4)

#### Coach Dennis Thurman and Jim O'Neil

This group is led by All-Pro **Darrelle Revis**, who in the Wild Card victory at IND (1/8), held the AFC's leading receiver, Reggie Wayne (111-1,355-6), to one catch for one yard. The secondary also returns starting **S Jim Leonhard** along with the safety tandem of **Eric Smith** and **Brodny Pool**. Pool started 12 of the 2010 contests, but Smith, who started six games last year, will get the nod in 2011. **CB Antonio Cromartie**, who this summer re-signed to a long-term deal with the Jets, is also back in the fold after finishing tied for the team lead with three interceptions. Second-year cornerback and 2010 first-round se-

lection **Kyle Wilson**, who earned starts in the first three games of the season as well as at CLV (11/14) and BUF (1/2) will be joined by **Donald Strickland**, a former Jet who spent 2010 with the San Diego Chargers as nickel cornerbacks. **Dwight Lowery**, who tied with Cromartie for the team-lead with three interceptions, moved to safety following a season-ending injury to Leonhard and made starts at PIT (12/19) and CHI (12/26). In his start at CHI, he intercepted and returned a Jay Cutler pass 20 yards for a touchdown. Prior to moving to safety, he clinched the Jets Week Five and Six wins, returning an interception for a touchdown with under 2:00 to play vs. MIN (10/11) and recovering a fumble at DEN (10/17) on the Broncos final play. The secondary is rounded out with young-veterans **Marquice Cole**, **Emanuel Cook** and **Ellis Lankster**. Cole had two interceptions in 2010, one of which he returned for a touchdown. Rookies **S Byron Landor**, **S Davon Morgan**, **CB Julian Posey** and **S Tracy Wilson** are all looking to earn a roster spot this summer.

### Specialists (3), Returning Starter (2)

#### Coach Mike Westhoff and Ben Kotwica

Kicker **Nick Folk** and long snapper **Tanner Purdum** are the only two returners of the group. Last season, Folk was the leading scorer for the team with 127 points, making 30 of 39 field goal attempts last season, including two game winners, in over time at DET (11/7) and at IND (1/8) in the AFC Wild Card playoff game. He also made all 37 PAT attempts. **T.J. Conley** entered his third training camp with the Jets and looks to secure the punter job.

# JETS NOTES

## ON THE MARK

**QB Mark Sanchez** has taken the New York Jets to the AFC Championship game in each of his first two seasons. It is Sanchez's postseason prowess that has propelled the Jets to four postseason victories over the last two years, all of which were on the road. In defeating the Cincinnati Bengals (1/9/10), San Diego Chargers (1/17/10), Indianapolis Colts (1/8/11) and New England Patriots (1/16/11), Sanchez has delivered in the difficult month of January. He ranks seventh all-time in NFL history for passer rating among all quarterbacks in their first six postseason starts, with a rating of 94.3. Out of all the quarterbacks listed below, only Sanchez made his first six postseason starts in his first two NFL seasons.

## CAPTAIN MARK

**QB Mark Sanchez** was one of five players chosen as team captains for 2011 by Head Coach Rex Ryan. Despite being only 24 years old, he has assumed a leadership role both on and off the field with the New York Jets. Sanchez is tied for the second-most victories by any quarterback in his first two seasons in the NFL, including the postseason. Only Ben Roethlisberger's 27 victories in his first two seasons were more than Sanchez's 23 wins with the Jets over the past two years. Four of Sanchez's 23 victories have been in the postseason.

## MEET THE OFFENSIVE LINE

In 2010, the New York Jets rushing attack finished fourth in the NFL, averaging 4.4 yards per an attempt and 148.4 yards a game. In 2009, the club finished the season leading the NFL in rushing, averaging 4.5 yards a carry and 172.3 yards a game. In six postseason games during the last two seasons, the line has allowed the Jets to average 130.8 yards rushing a game. It is the most by any team that has played more than two postseason games during the span.

LT **D'Brickshaw Ferguson**, selected 4th overall in the 2006 NFL Draft, earned his 2nd Pro Bowl appearance in 2010. Named to the All-Rookie Team by *Pro Football Weekly* and the Pro Football Writers' Association in '06.

LG **Matt Slason**, originally selected in the sixth round of the 2009 NFL Draft. He earned a starting position this summer on a unit that helped the Jets lead the NFL in rushing last season.

C **Nick Mangold**, a three-time Pro Bowl selection, earned first-team All-Pro honors in 2009-10. Selected in the first round of the 2006 NFL Draft (29th overall), Mangold has started every game of his career.

RG **Brandon Moore** has helped pave the way for two of the Jets three best rushing seasons. In 2009, the club rushed for a franchise-best 2,756 yards, while the team's 2004 total of 2,388 ranks third-best in team history. In those seasons, he blocked for two rushing champions: Curtis Martin (1,697, 2004 NFL rushing title) and Thomas Jones (1,312, 2008 AFC rushing title). Originally joined the Jets as an undrafted FA defensive tackle in 2002. Moved to guard during the 2003 offseason and earned the starting right guard position in 2004.

RT **Wayne Hunter** made his first start at tackle in place of an injured Damien Woody at PIT (12/19). He went on to make starts at CHI (1/26) and vs. BUF (1/2) prior to Woody's return in the club's Wild Card game at IND (1/8). After Woody suffered an injury in the Wild Card game, Hunter started the Jets final two postseason games. A former third-round selection in the 2003 NFL Draft by SEA, he has seen action as a tight end and sparingly at tackle since joining the Jets on the practice squad on 12/26/07.

# JETS NOTES

## 75 SINCE 2006

In 2006, Jets **General Manager Mike Tannenbaum** focused on the offensive line selecting **LT D'Brickshaw Ferguson** fourth overall and **C Nick Mangold** 29th overall in the NFL draft. The two players have started 80 consecutive regular season games together, making them the only two players who entered the league together to start their team's first 75 regular-season games on the same offensive line since 1970. Ferguson has earned 2010 *Pro Football Weekly's* Mid-season All-Pro team honors, 2009 and 2010 Pro Bowl honors and 2006 All-Rookie Team honors by *Pro Football Weekly* and the Pro Football Writer's Association. During his first four seasons, Mangold has earned 2009 and 2010 *Associated Press* All-Pro honors, three-consecutive Pro Bowl selections (08-10) and All-Rookie team in 2006 as voted by *Pro Football Weekly* and the Pro Football Writer's Association.

## DUSTIN KELLER IN PERSPECTIVE

Since being selected in the first round of the 2008 NFL Draft, **TE Dustin Keller** has quietly had the best first three seasons by a tight end in club history. Despite working with two quarterbacks in his three seasons (Brett Favre '08 & Mark Sanchez '09-'10), Keller has caught 148 passes for 1,744 yards, the most by a Jets tight end in their first three NFL seasons.

## BURRESS RETURNS

Free agent acquisition **WR Plaxico Burress** showed no signs of rust in the Jets' home preseason opener against the Cincinnati Bengals, a 27-7 win, catching three passes for 66 yards and a touchdown. Burress' return came 1,001 days after he last played on Nov. 23 (NYG at ARZ).

## MASON 60+ AND 750+

**WR Derrick Mason** joins the Jets as the NFL's third active leader in receiving yards (11,891), and fourth active leader in receptions (924). Mason, who signed with New York on August 7, has been one of the league's most reliable receivers since entering the NFL in 1997. He has compiled eight 1,000-yard seasons, while maintaining an average of 849 yards per season and missing just six regular season games in his 14 seasons.

This year, Mason can become the first player in NFL history to record 60-plus catches and 750-plus receiving yardage in 12 consecutive seasons. He currently is tied with two other players at 11 straight 60-750 seasons — Hall of Fame WR Jerry Rice and TE Tony Gonzalez.

## STONE TIME

Living up to his reputation of making key plays at big moments, **WR Santonio Holmes** caught his second game-winning touchdown pass in as many weeks from **QB Mark Sanchez** vs. HST (11/21). The score, with 10 seconds remaining, gave the club a 30-27 victory. He

finished the game with his second 100-yard receiving game (7-126-2) in three weeks. His first came at DET (11/7), when he caught five passes for 114 yards.

One week earlier at CLV (11/14), Holmes caught a Sanchez throw and raced 37 yards for the game-winning touchdown, his first score as a Jet, with 16 seconds remaining in overtime. It was the fourth game that season that Holmes made the key play that led to a game winning score. Week Nine at DET (11/17), Holmes took a pass 52 yards to setup **K Nick Folk's** game-winning 30-yard field goal. At DEN (10/17), he drew a 46-yard pass interference penalty to setup **RB LaDainian Tomlinson's** game-winning touchdown.

For the season, Holmes totaled 52 receptions for 746 yards (14.3 avg.) and six touchdowns.

## SACKS BY PACE

**LB Calvin Pace** finished the 2010 season just 0.5 sacks behind Jets' sack leader LB Bryan Thomas with 5.5, despite missing the first four games due to injury. For the season, he finished with 55 tackles. It is the second-consecutive season that he has missed the first four games of the schedule. Pace led the Jets in sacks in both 2008 (7) and 2009 (8). In the last game of the season vs. BUF (1/2), Pace recorded the second interception of his career along with a sack, three PD, three QHs and a tackle.

Pace continued his sack production in the postseason, taking down Peyton Manning in the Wild Card game (1/8 at IND), dropping Tom Brady in the Divisional game (1/16 at NE) and capping the postseason with a seven-yard sack of Ben Roethlisberger (1/23 at PIT).

For his career, Pace has recorded 34.5 sacks, 20.5 since joining the Jets in 2008. He has also recorded 14 forced fumbles, nine since joining the club.

## SMITH BLOCKS IT

**Eric Smith** has become an invaluable member of Mike Westhoff's special teams unit, ranking second on the team with 15 special teams tackles. Eric Smith is called upon for a big play from time-to-time.

For the second time in two seasons, Smith blocked a punt attempt when he got to Brandon Fields in the third quarter at MIA (9/26/10), allowing the Jets to take over possession at the Miami 17-yard line.

Smith's first blocked punt came last season when he blocked a Chris Hanson punt that Brad Smith scooped up for a four-yard touchdown at NE (11/22/09). Smith also blocked a Matt Dodge punt in the pre-season against the Giants (8/16/10).

## PHILLY CONNECTIONS

**Buddy Ryan**, the father of Jets head coach **Rex**, spent five seasons as the Eagles head coach, amassing a 43-35-1 record over five seasons with the club and leading them to postseason berths in his final three seasons.

Jets **Defensive Coordinator Mike Pettine** hails from Doylestown, PA, located less than 30 miles away from Lincoln Financial Field. Pettine was an all-state quarterback at Central Bucks West, under his father, legendary high school coach Mike Pettine Sr. He began his coaching career at his alma mater, and made stops at local schools, William Tennant in Warminster, PA, and North Penn, in Lancaster, PA, before joining the pro ranks.
